Visiting: The nursing home and assisted living facility remains open for visiting. Visitors must follow the CDC core principles of infection control regardless of one's vaccination status while visiting in the facility:

- All visitors MUST screen in for symptoms, temperature and wear a face covering. Please stop at the table in the lobby to complete the screening process.
- Please utilize the hand sanitizer dispensers while in the facility. Hand washing is key to containing the spread of any infection.
- Visitors need to go directly to the resident room or visiting area.

The nursing home door is locked at 4:30 p.m. each evening and opened at 6:30 a.m. each morning. If the door is locked when you arrive for a visit, please ring the doorbell or call this number: 660-973-3320. This number is for the front door of the nursing home only. A charge nurse will answer the phone. Please be understanding/patient because the nurse cannot always answer the phone immediately or come to the front door as quickly as visitors would like.

For the assisted living apartments, the front door is always locked, but visitors may call 660-973-8182 and a staff person will respond to the front door. The doorbell also can be used.

COVID Testing: Testing for COVID 19 is a daily practice at Morningside Center. If any resident or staff member is showing symptoms, they are tested immediately instead of waiting for the next scheduled testing day. Scheduled testing days are Mondays and Thursday at this time.

TESTING OF RESIDENTS AND STAFF 02/21/2022:

- Two Nursing Home residents tested POSITIVE: These are the first positive tests for residents since 08/27/2021. Both are quarantined and being monitored. Family members have been notified.
