COVID Testing: Testing for COVID 19 is a daily practice at Morningside Center. If any resident or staff member is showing symptoms, they are tested immediately instead of waiting for the next scheduled testing day. Scheduled testing days are Mondays and Thursdays at this time.

TESTING OF RESIDENTS AND STAFF 02/24/2022:

- Two additional nursing home residents tested POSITIVE. They are quarantined and are being monitored. Family members have been notified. The current total is 4 positive resident cases.
- Assisted Living Facility Residents: NO POSITIVES
- Staff: NO POSITIVES

The nursing home and assisted living facility remain open for visiting.

The nursing home door is locked at 4:30 p.m. each evening and opened at 6:30 a.m. each morning. If the door is locked when you arrive for a visit, please ring the doorbell or call this number: 660-973-3320. This number is for the front door of the nursing home only. A charge nurse will answer the phone. Please be understanding/patient because the nurse cannot always answer the phone immediately or come to the front door as quickly as visitors would like.

For the assisted living apartments, the front door is always locked, but visitors may call 660-973-8182 and a staff person will respond to the front door. The doorbell also can be used.
